Akita City Tsuchizaki Minato Port Area, Opened in March 2018. There are touch-panel displays to showcase the Historical Museum 秋田市 上崎みなと Tsuchizaki Port by theme. You can experience an impressive float (11.5 meters tall, renewed in November 2023) from the "Tsuchizaki Shinmeisha Shrine Annual Celebration and Float Festival", which has been registered as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage, as well as the video of the Float Festival. You will also find a model of a ship so-called "Kitamaebune", and a monitor displaying a portion of the Akita Kaido Picture Scroll in its actual size. You can also learn about the Tsuchizaki Air Raid, one of the last air raids in Japan in World War II from actual documents and dioramas as well as displays of parts of buildings that were bombed.




